DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

The AKC Canine Partners program is for mixed breed dogs and dogs ineligible for AKC registration. For more information, see <http://www.akc.org/mixedbreeds/index.cfm>.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the *Regulations for Agility Trials*. All contact equipment is rubberized.

All classes will take place outdoors on beautiful green grass.
Ring size will be 100 x 100 feet

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

All dogs competing in agility must possess an official AKC Jump Height Card or temporary jump height form per the Height Card Regulations. **If you do not have official proof of measurement, it is your responsibility to get measured at this trial.** Dogs must be entered in the jump height they are eligible for, or the handler-optional 24C" jump height.

FOOD CONCESSION

There will not be a food vendor at this trial. There are restaurants within 5 miles of the event site.

RIBBONS, AWARDS AND PRIZES

First through Fourth place Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class for qualifying scores. Qualifying ribbons awarded to all dog and handler teams receiving qualifying scores. No ribbons, awards and prizes will be mailed.

Titling rosettes offered to dogs finishing an agility title at these trials.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- This trial will be conducted under the American Kennel Club Regulations for Agility Trials. For copies of the Regulations visit AKC website online at: www.akc.org.
- The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- Host club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the host club or any official thereof.
- Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.
- Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to inform the gate stewards of possible conflicts before their turn.
- Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. No dogs allowed in the restrooms. Please pick up after your dogs.
- **All dogs must be on leash at all times, except when in the ring or when in designated warm-up areas.**

REFUNDS

- No refunds for overpayment of \$10.00 or less.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, a public emergency, act of a public enemy, weather or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- No entry fee refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.
- Refunds for injured dogs or handlers: 50% refund given in Jump City Jump Bucks for a dog or handler that has a note from their veterinarian or doctor saying they cannot participate in the show. The doctor's appointment must occur before the show.
- Full Entry fees refunded if withdrawing an entry before the closing date/ time.
- Online convenience fees not refunded for any reason.
- Host club is under no obligation to offer refunds for duplicate entries for the same dog.
- Bitches in season cannot compete in Agility Trials, nor allowed on the show grounds. As such, the club will issue full refund less \$10.00 processing fee for bitches unable to compete for this reason if the Trial Secretary receives WRITTEN notice of withdrawal no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Refund given as Jump City Jump Bucks.
- Change of judge, after the distribution of the premium list, if the judging assignment changes, an exhibitor has the right to request a full refund of their entry fees for any class affected. Exhibitors must submit requests in writing to the Trial Secretary a minimum of 30 minutes preceding the start of the event on the first day the exhibitor is entered

MOVE-UPS

- The Trial Secretary must receive move-up requests by **6:00 PM MST the Monday before the trial**. Requests must be made via email.
- There will be day-to-day move-ups at the show, provided the Trial Secretary receives them within 15 minutes after the end of the last class.
- There will be no move-ups in the morning before the start of the trial. EXCEPTION: A dog entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions:
- The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class.
- Move Down: After the close of entries a dog may be moved down in its class level (i.e. Master to Excellent). The request must be in writing and submitted to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

ENTERING A MIXTURE OF REGULAR AND PREFERRED CLASSES WITHIN THE SAME TRIAL WEEKEND – MULTIPLE JUMP HEIGHTS WITHIN THE SAME TRIAL DAY

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day. Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO) RUNS

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment.

FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
- Toys must be non-audible
- Toys may not leave the handler's hand
- Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

FIX AND GO ON (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

ENTRY FEES & PAPERLESS ENTRY

Each row on the entry form represents an event. Entry fees are PER EVENT. \$22 for the first run per event. \$16 for subsequent runs per event.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
